MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT

1. Matihetihe Marae Trust hereby gives notice of its intention to appear as an interested party under section 104 of the Marine and Coastal Area (Takutai Moana) Act 2011 in relation to the application for a recognition order filed by the trustees of Te Runanga o Te Rarawa (**Te Rarawa**).
2. The application for a recognition order filed by Te Rarawa was publicly notified on 28 April 2017.
3. Matihetihe Marae Trust is the representative body for the hapu of Te Tao Maui me Te Hokoheha.
4. On 3 April 2017, Te Rarawa filed an application for a recognition order in the High Court (CIV-2017-485-290) in relation to the common coastal marine area in which Te Tao Maui me Te Hokoheha have interests.
5. Part of the common coastal marine area to which the application by Te Rarawa relates overlaps with the area that is the subject of the application by Matihetihe Marae Trust.
6. Matihetihe Marae Trust therefore gives notice that, in relation to the application for a recognition order filed by Te Rarawa, it:
 - (a) intends to be formally recorded and appear as an interested party;
 - (b) wishes to be served with copies of all documents filed; and
 - (c) wishes to reserve its right to participate, including by filing and presenting evidence and submissions, in any judicial conferences and interlocutory or substantive hearings.
